

Can I wear my own clothes?

What do I need to do?

- Remember—it is important to choose those subjects that you really want to 'taste' rather than going for those that your friends have chosen, just so that you can be together.

Will I get to do the sessions I choose?

- During the day, you will get the opportunity to take part in two out of the four different options you have chosen. However.....
- Some of the sessions last the whole morning in which case you will only be able to 'taste' one — these are clearly labelled throughout so please take this into consideration when making your choices
- Please bear in mind though that many of the workshops have a maximum capacity of 15—20 students and you will be allocated on a first come first served basis.
- We will fit you in to two of your four choices.
- Where we are unable to accommodate you in any of your choices, we will contact you to discuss further options.

Brickwork (must wear strong shoes ideally with steel toe cap)

Carpentry & Joinery (must wear strong shoes ideally with steel toe cap)

Electrical (must wear strong shoes ideally with steel toe cap)

Engineering -manufacturing, electrical / electronics

(wear safety shoes and overalls, alternatively strong shoes and clothing that can get dirty- although this will limit involvement in tasks)

Furniture (must wear strong shoes ideally with steel toe cap)

Motor Vehicle (wear safety shoes and overalls, alternatively strong shoes and clothing that can get dirty— although this will limit involvement in tasks)

Plumbing (must wear strong shoes ideally with steel toe cap)

Beauty Therapy (must wear black trousers, white shirt and enclosed flat shoes)

Childcare & Education (Ensure you're ready to make and stick!)

Hairdressing (Must wear black trousers, white polo shirt and enclosed flat shoes)

Catering (Must wear black trousers, white shirt and enclosed flat shoes)

Public Services (Must wear comfy clothing and trainers)

Sport (must wear indoor/outdoor sports wear appropriate for fitness suitable for fitness suite and AstroTurf. Please bring waterproof /warm as appropriate)

Note: All these work shops will be timetabled across a double session. You will meet at Folly Lane campus then transported/escorted to required venue.

Equine* (must wear sturdy footwear, covered toes, trousers and t-shirt coving shoulders, waterproof/warm as appropriate. If you already owned a riding hat and gloves please bring but not necessary)

Animal Care* (must wear stout boots, cloths you don't mind getting messy, hair tied back, no jewellery)

Agriculture / Farming* (Stout boots and outdoor clothing required)

Countryside - Tree Identification/ Tracks and Trapping* (Stout boots and outdoor clothing required)

Blacksmithing* (Forging - demo if no PPE. Forging – have a go if wearing steel toe cap boots and cotton based clothing - no synthetics materials)

Welding* (Steel toe cap boots and cotton based clothing, no synthetics materials)

Please find below the options for the taster sessions being offered by Hereford College of Arts. Please note that all workshops last for one session giving you the opportunity to experience another workshop.

Performing Arts

Jazz Dance workshop (Participants will take part in a Jazz dance workshop and should wear comfortable clothes suitable for movement)

Slap Stick Comedy Workshop (*Participants will take part in a slapstick workshop and should wear comfortable clothes suitable for movement*)

Music

Song Writing Workshop (Join other young musicians in this specialised song writing workshop)

Art & Design

Fashion Design (An opportunity to look at this very popular creative industry and experiment with drawing and collage)

Ceramics (Experiment with clay. This 'hands on' workshop takes place in a specialist Ceramic Studio and participants produce a piece of clay artwork)

Fabric printing (Print a bag. This workshop teaches participants how to screen print a design onto a bag in the specialist Textile Studio)

Photography (An overview of the skills and techniques required to successfully take pictures)

Animation (Stop frame animation. This workshop looks at producing a short piece of animation using iPads)

Graphic Design (A look at the many aspects involved in this exciting field producing graphic images)

Painting & Drawing (Participants will engage in a painting and drawing session learning new techniques in a dedicated studio)

Metal Sculpture workshop (Participants will design and produce a piece of wire sculpture in the specialist 3D workshop)
