


Hereford Sixth Form College is proud to have a 'create your own' approach to the Programme of Study, and these Vocational Pathways are no different. Each pathway will have suggestions for courses to choose from whilst being centred around a particular vocational course.

Results for vocational courses are consistently outstanding; in 2020, 100% of students studying BTEC qualifications receiving a pass or above. Hereford Sixth Form College candidates perform better than the average for the country; the average grade was a Distinction- whilst the national average is a Merit+.

The Vocational Pathways include recommendations for relevant enrichment activities and extension programmes to enhance employability and enrich the College experience. These include short courses, which are not examined, that teach students valuable life skills such as Emergency First Aid and Sign Language.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

To gain a place on a Level 3 course, you will need at least five GCSEs at grades 4 - 9 or A* - C including English Language. If you have not achieved grade 4 or above in English Language or Mathematics, you will be expected to study these subjects at Hereford Sixth Form College until the minimum requirement grade has been achieved.

CREATING YOUR OWN PROGRAMME OF STUDY

The Level 3 Programme of Study consists of three options. Some students may choose to take on four options. A Levels take up one option; vocational courses can take up one, two or three options, as shown in the guide to the left.

You can combine these different elements to create your own individual programme of study. Options are incredibly flexible, with 99% of combinations possible. It is important that you choose what you enjoy as well as what will qualify you for any future career aim.

The aim of the booklet is to give you an idea of the different course combinations that can lead to certain career paths.

The Level 3 Programme of Study is supplemented with the Tutorial Programme, Impact, the Extended Project Qualification and Certificate in Mathematical Studies.
