

THE HEREFORDSHIRE MUSIC FUND



The Herefordshire Music Fund is a charity established to provide financial assistance for the provision of music lessons to young people living in Herefordshire or attending a school in Herefordshire, who would otherwise have difficulty in accessing Music through financial hardship.

Applicants will be required to submit a Grant Application together with evidence of their financial circumstances.

Currently, the maximum grant will be £364.50, which is equivalent to 90% of the cost of 30 half-hour lessons at the current 'accredited teacher' rate of £27.00 per hour.

Grants will be awarded for a year but paid termly on a retrospective basis on receipt of evidence of expenditure.

In addition to evidence of payment for lessons, a satisfactory report form completed by the teacher will be required prior to payment of the grant for terms 2 and 3. In exceptional circumstances, a proportion of the grant may be paid in advance.

Students wishing to receive a grant for a further year must submit evidence of progress such as having passed an Associated Board grade exam at an appropriate level.

Claim forms and blank report forms will be issued to successful applicants.
